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NAPA COUNTY SAFETY NET FOOD PROGRAMS

“Who are The Hungry in the Napa Valley?”

The Safety Net Food Committee meets monthly to collaborate on the needs of all the food programs, including churches and non-profit organizations, that provide meals or food in Napa County.

Napa Valley Food Bank – The ongoing needs of this program continue to rise. Each year, the Napa Valley Food Bank serves thousands of families, with nearly 40% served being children under the age of 18. In 2015 the Food Bank served over 45,000 individuals, distributing over 1,620,000 lbs of food. In addition, 41 non-profit agencies are able to utilize the Food Bank in order to offset their food needs.

Meals on Wheels – Meals on Wheels delivers, on average, 105,600 meals per year to the region’s seniors 5 days a week. Over 400 meals are prepared each day for delivery throughout Napa County. No one is turned away and there is no fee to the client.

The Table – The Table has served more than half a million meals to date, serving an average 120 people per day, and approximately 30,000 per year. They mainly see working poor, who struggle from paycheck to paycheck in order to survive.

The Salvation Army - The Salvation Army serves, on average, 175 per day, 42,000 per year. They also see working poor, who struggle from paycheck to paycheck in order to survive.

Food Vouchers – Food vouchers are distributed among programs throughout Napa County (such as Cope Family Center, Napa Emergency Women’s Services, American Canyon Family Resources Center, St. Vincent de Paul and Puertas Abiertas Community Resources Center) to help with crisis situations that need to be addressed immediately. Families that have no other alternatives have access to the voucher program for food.

Turkeys and Holiday Baskets – Each year the Food Bank, Catholic Charities, The Table and American Canyon Family Resource Center work tirelessly to find turkeys for the Holiday Assistance Program. This program serves the poorest of our community and enables families to have a holiday meal.
